**C-x C-s** save document

**C-x C-c** exit Emacs

**C-x u** undo

**C-k** cut text (“k” for kill)

**C-y** paste text (“y” for yank from buffer)

**C-a** move to beginning of line

**C-e** move to end of line

**C-s** search

**ESC %** find and replace

**ESC f** move right by one word (“f” for forward)

**ESC b** move left by one word (“b” for backward)

**ESC >** move to bottom of document

**ESC <** move to top of document

You might also want to learn how to insert the contents of another document into the current document and how to keep several documents open at once.
