ls list files

ls -l list files in the long format

ls -a list all the files

cd change directory

cd libraries move into subfolder called libraries

cd .. move to the parent directory

cd - move to the previous directory

mkdir make a folder in the current directory

cp copy a file

cp -r copy a folder (and everything in it)

mv move a file or rename a file

rm -i remove or delete a file (with prompt)

pwd print working directory

PS1='– >' changes terminal prompt

bash puts you into desired command shell
