# The Revival of Emotional Appeals in Charts and Graphs

Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2016

We usually think of charts and graphs as purely rational and objective forms of visual communication. However, emotional appeals have long been associated with data design. In the later nineteenth century, many new varieties of charts and graphs were invented that included emotional appeals in the form of color, novelty, and lavish detail.

Although modernism largely expunged emotional aspects of data design, recent developments in data visualization have reintroduced emotion through color, novelty, and the personalizing effects of interactivity. In this presentation I will show the origins of emotional appeals and their recent resurgence in data visualizations.


