- Fred Brooks
 - Worked at IBM
 - Was in charge of the IBM 360 project
 - drew lessons from his experience
 - e.g., hiring more people might slow rather than speed up progress!
 - Wrote the essay titled The Mythical Man-Month
 - The essay was later developed into a book
- Waterfall model
 - sequential, assumes that we can know requirements at the start
 - Requirements Analysis (What do the people want?)
 - Specifications (quantify requirements)
 - Design
 - Coding
 - Test Run (lots of testing)
 - Release the beast and teach
 - maintenance (the hard stuff)
 - Run it till the wheels fall off
- Agile
 - get something in the hands of customers as quickly as possible—
“minimum viable product (MVP)”
 - short deadlines—2 weeks
 - Simplicity for the masses to modify for constant optimization
 - Frequent feedback
 - Testing and coding begin simultaneously
 - Small teams (two pizzas make a team)
